Adopt-A-Trail Program

The City of Pflugerville Parks and Recreation Department encourages families, neighborhoods, Community or civic groups, businesses, youth groups, schools, and individuals to get involved in the beautification of the trails system.

Eligible Sites

The City of Pflugerville trail system includes 30.5 miles of trails. Any trail recognized as a City of Pflugerville maintained trail is eligible and worthy of an Adopt-A-Trail partner. Trail assignments will be made on a first-come basis. Maps are available online at www.pflugervilletx.gov/adoptatrail.

How it Works

Once a trail has been assigned, the adopting group will commit to help maintain the adopted trail for a minimum of two years. Within those two years, the group will perform maintenance a minimum of four times per adopted year, including the city’s annual Clean Up Day held in April. Maintenance will include, litter pick up, weeding and debris removal. The Pflugerville Parks and Recreation Department will continue to provide regular maintenance to each adopted area but, with your help we can do better.

Reporting

At the conclusion of each clean up, the group will provide a report to the Parks and Recreation Department documenting your efforts. Additionally, all groups are asked to submit a trail inspection report to the Department after each clean up. Program Information Continued

Trash Removal

The Pflugerville Parks and Recreation Department will provide trash bags to groups upon request. All trash must be placed in bags. Objects too large/heavy shall be placed next to filled trash bags. Full bags are to be placed next to the trail for pick up.

Termination of Agreement

The City of Pflugerville reserves the right to terminate an agreement at any time if the adopting group is not meeting the terms and conditions of the agreement. Groups failing to follow the guidelines or not participating in the city's annual Clean Up Day will have their application terminated and sign removed. Groups wanting to terminate their agreement with the city must provide 30 days notice.

Renewal

Renewal of agreements and continuation in the Adopt-A-Trail program will be subject to the approval of the Parks and Recreation Director.

Release

The group shall release, relieve, hold harmless, and indemnify the City, its agents, servants, and employees for any and all actions, claims, injuries, lawsuits arising out of or in any way connected to the activities of the Adopt-A-Trail program.
